Can you send me a list of folks that you think would be the right mix for a broadband coverage meeting? Also, give me some dates that work for you to hold this meeting. This first meeting, as we earlier discussed, should be held in Tally, to access the system below. I believe we need to get this one started. We have travel costs for a group to meet and set out the key issues related to coverage.

Once I have your recommended list and available dates, I will get the agenda built, team together, and handle all arrangements.

Draft Goals:

1. Assess Florida's broadband coverage—both now and in the future
2. Make recommendations for rural coverage area needs for the proposed FN system
3. Prioritize rural coverage actions needed in the proposed FN system
4. Discuss tribal coverage needs for the Miccosukee and Seminole Tribes
5. Discuss coverage needs for large metro areas and in-building coverage, off-shore coverage, and other issues, as determined by the subcommittee.

Deliverables: 1. A document to be shared with the FloridaNet Advisory Committee for edits. 2. Final edited recommendations for the FloridaNet Executive Committee to consider.

It would be preferable to have this meeting before the meeting with FirstNet, but I understand the collisions with the Holiday's.
