Contract Vehicle Survey	Status update on Pilot -Key findings -Lessons learned Next steps -Review	-G Holcomb comments 98 surveys started, 62 completed surveys Approximately 200 emails went out to Region 5 contacts Lessons learned: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Don't get ahead of ourselves. We caused confusion when two emails went out. • Communicate the requirements early in a separate message—I/O meeting or other meeting • Use Web-link, email links are unique to recipients and can't be forwarded • Recommend a regional review of data to eliminate duplicate data and gather missing information Results: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most responders were local fire services • 32% of respondents need two carriers or more to fulfill public safety mission. The reason for multiple carriers was Coverage and Reliability. • 66.13% of respondents indicated that employees have 2 more devices that utilize LTE data • Top 3 reasons public safety mission uses were: texting, CAD, and AVL Next Steps <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request approval to proceed with state-wide roll out of survey • FloridaNet will meet with I/O chairs and obtain points of

CASM Next Gen	CASM Next Gen as mapping/data collection tool	<p>-Owned, and maintained by DHS/OEC</p> <p>-Currently used as a LMR tool, available to public safety organizations—there is a lot of overlap in LTE and LMR data</p> <p>-Data needs to be refreshed—SLIGP and FirstNet represent an opportunity for Florida to re-invigorate this tool and usage of the tool state-wide.</p> <p>-Florida is partnering with OEC to recommend additions of LTE/FirstNet information</p> <p>-FloridaNet team is working with FirstNet, NTIA, OEC to establish data collection plan</p> <p>-Spring workshops will be conducted with DHS/OEC to discuss data collection efforts and approach</p>
