# PURPOSE


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- Conduct education and outreach

  - Presentation of requirements collected to date, state plan schedule update, decision process overview




# REGIONAL WORKSHOPS

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- Phased Roll-Out Plan
  - Draft will be reviewed at regional workshops
  - Will include input from state and local PSEs, FloridaNet Executive and Technical Committees
- State Plan Review Process
  - Must be ready no later than when FirstNet releases the state plans
  - Process will include recommendations from the Executive Committee
  - Will ultimately be used to evaluate FirstNet plan against needs of the user community
